

PRINCIPLES AND CONDITIONS FOR CONNECTING WITH THE GLOBAL PEACE EARTH ALLIANCE

1. The Mission of the Global Peace Earth Alliance

The Global Peace Earth Alliance is an international civic initiative and space for connection whose purpose is to help people, communities, organisations and initiatives find one another, become visible and build relationships with each other—those who, on the shared foundation of our common humanity, serve life and choose peace.

The Global Peace Earth Alliance is founded on the recognition that, in many parts of the world, countless people and communities are already working to protect life, uphold human dignity, promote peace, strengthen communities, care for nature and safeguard future generations. We may act in different fields, come from different traditions and use different means, yet beneath all these differences lies a deeper common ground: our shared humanity, which serves life and chooses peace.

The purpose of the Global Peace Earth Alliance is to connect and make visible this human and community strength that already exists.

2. The Legal and Organisational Nature of the Initiative

In this document, the name Global Peace Earth Alliance does not refer to an independent legal entity or to an alliance in the legal sense, but to an international civic initiative and network for connection.

Connecting with the initiative does not create membership in an association, membership in an alliance, or any other form of organisational membership.

Connected individuals, communities and organisations retain their full legal, organisational, worldview and operational independence.

In Hungary, the organisational background and operation of the initiative involve the Civil Value Preservation Association, as well as the individuals and communities presented on the initiative's website.

3. Our Common Foundation

The basis for connecting with the Global Peace Earth Alliance is not political, religious, ideological or economic identity, but a shared minimum of humanity centred on respect for life, human dignity and peace.

The spirit of the initiative is defined by the principles published on the Global Peace Earth Alliance website. As a shared civilisational compass, these principles express, in particular:

- the sanctity and primacy of life;
- the unity of humanity and nature;
- respect for reality, knowledge and truth;
- the unity of freedom, self-determination and responsibility;

- the role of the economy in serving life and community;
- our shared responsibility for natural resources;
- the importance of community, social security and human self-reliance;
- the limitation of power and community self-determination;
- the ethical responsibility of technological development;
- the value of cultural and community diversity, and mutual respect;
- peace as an active civilisational responsibility;
- responsibility towards future generations.

Connection does not imply acceptance of any single political, religious, economic or social system. The shared principles provide direction while respecting the cultural, historical, social and worldview diversity of individuals, peoples and communities.

4. Who Can Connect?

The Global Peace Earth Alliance is open as a space for connection to:

individuals, local communities, civil society organisations, associations and foundations, peace communities, cultural and artistic communities, religious communities, educational and professional groups, social initiatives, businesses, municipalities and other community actors, as well as national and international groups and organisations whose activities they consider compatible with the common foundation of the Global Peace Earth Alliance.

A condition of connection is that the applicant becomes familiar with the principles of the initiative, agrees with their essential spirit, and does not, through their own activities, act in a manner that is clearly contrary to the fundamental values of life, human dignity, peaceful coexistence and mutual respect.

5. What Does Connection Mean?

Connection expresses that a person, community or organisation recognises our common human foundation and, while preserving its independence, wishes to connect with those who act in service of life and peace.

Connection may create opportunities for participants to:

- introduce themselves within the international network of the Global Peace Earth Alliance;
- make their own activities, initiatives and events visible;
- discover other connected communities and initiatives;
- establish relationships with them;
- share experience, knowledge and good practices;
- participate in joint events and collaborations.

The aim of the Global Peace Earth Alliance is that, over time, through the website and its connection system, participating people, communities, organisations, initiatives and events will become increasingly easy for one another to find and reach.

6. The Independence of Those Who Connect

Connection does not create a relationship of hierarchy or subordination.

A connected organisation continues its activities in its own name, according to its own purposes, within its own decision-making system and under its own responsibility.

The Global Peace Earth Alliance is not authorised to make statements, undertake obligations or make legal declarations on behalf of a connected organisation, unless that organisation has given a separate and explicit authorisation to do so.

Likewise, a connected organisation is not authorised, merely on the basis of its connection, to make statements or undertake obligations on behalf of the Global Peace Earth Alliance, the Civil Value Preservation Association or any other connected organisation.

7. Respect for Diversity

One of the fundamental values of the Global Peace Earth Alliance is diversity.

Connected people and communities may differ in nationality, religion, worldview, culture, social circumstances, political convictions, professional activities and also in the paths through which they wish to serve life and peace.

Connection therefore does not mean that participants agree with every view, position or activity of one another.

The common denominator of connection is our shared humanity: respect for life, human dignity, mutual respect and the choice of peace.

8. Appearance on the Global Peace Earth Alliance Website

A connected person, community or organisation may request that its introduction be displayed on the Global Peace Earth Alliance website and its connection platforms.

For publication, the applicant may provide, in particular:

their name; the name of their organisation or initiative; a brief introduction; their field of activity; their country and locality; contact details for their website or community page; their logo; information about their own events; and images and other content supplied by them for publication.

The applicant provides the data and content necessary for publication at their own discretion and declares that they are entitled to publish them and to authorise the use of the logos, images and other content provided.

The detailed conditions governing the processing of personal data are set out in a separate Privacy Notice.

9. Approval of Publication

Because the Global Peace Earth Alliance is a values-based space for connection, submitting an application does not result in automatic publication.

Before publication, the operators of the initiative may examine whether the applicant's introduction and publicly available activities are compatible with the fundamental spirit of the Global Peace Earth Alliance and with these conditions of connection.

Publication may be refused, or an already published introduction may be removed, if the applicant's activities or conduct in the name of the Global Peace Earth Alliance are clearly and seriously contrary to the fundamental values of the initiative, violate the law, infringe the human dignity or rights of others, encourage violence or hatred, or use the name of the Global Peace Earth Alliance in a misleading manner.

Such a decision does not constitute a judgement of the applicant's entire activities or worldview; it only determines whether their appearance may remain within the Global Peace Earth Alliance's own space for connection.

10. Use of the Name, Logo and Visual Identity

Appearance on the website does not in itself authorise a connected person or organisation to use the name Global Peace Earth Alliance or its visual identity elements as part of its own organisational name, in a manner suggesting representative authority, or for commercial purposes.

Logos, marks and visual identity elements expressly made available by the Global Peace Earth Alliance for connected communities and event organisers may be used in accordance with the applicable terms of use.

A connected organisation's own name and logo may appear on the Global Peace Earth Alliance platforms with the organisation's consent.

11. Ending the Connection

Connection is voluntary.

A connected person, community or organisation may request at any time the removal of its introduction and of any indication of its connection.

The operators of the Global Peace Earth Alliance may likewise end the appearance in cases of serious or persistent violation of the conditions set out in this document.

The provisions of the Privacy Notice govern the deletion and further processing of personal data.

12. Our Shared Responsibility

The Global Peace Earth Alliance does not seek to make the people and communities connected to it uniform; rather, it seeks to make visible what unites us alongside our differences.

We believe that the diversity of humanity is a value, while we share responsibility for life, for the Earth, for one another's human dignity and for the generations that will follow us.

Peace is not merely the absence of war, but a condition for which people and communities must work every day.

Let us find one another, make visible all that we do for life and peace, and create the possibility for many separate actions to become connection, for connection to become cooperation, and for cooperation to give rise to an ever stronger, active shared will!

One planet, many peoples, many cultures — one shared future!
